I am currently studying in the fourth year of Architectural Technology. The focus for this year's project is a training facility for the Inverness football team to bring them back to the city. This extends my current knowledge of noise and heat transfer in a sports based building.

In Third year of the same course I attained an A for a project to design a visitor attraction for Loch Ness by Jacobite Cruises company. This was an off-site manufactured Cross Laminated Timber proposal giving the client the desired covered waiting area and hosting venue for personal use, as well as recording studio for local artists.

Completed a Second Graded Unit. In the HND year my focus was on a commercial and larger scale architectural design as well as the technologies involved in these buildings.
